

Bournewood's Virtual PHP

With the current COVID-19 situation Bournewood was looking for a way to provide partial hospital services without putting patients at risk. The solution is virtual PHP!

Here is what you need to join:

- Laptop, desktop, tablet, Chromebook or smartphone with internet access
- OR
- Access to a telephone

How does this program work?

We are using Microsoft teams to run four therapeutic groups a day. We are also providing individual check-ins, family meetings and psychopharmacology all via Microsoft teams or telephone. What you need:

- Email
- Internet connection
- PC, laptop, tablet, smartphone
- OR
- Telephone connection

You can access the PHP in two ways:

1. Audio & Visual:
If you have access to the internet and have a smartphone, tablet, Chromebook, laptop or PC you will be invited by the group leader through Microsoft Teams via email. You can download the Microsoft Team's app or use the web browser version. You will need to set up a username and password as well.
2. Phone:
If you only have a phone, you will be given a phone number with a conference code to join the group. The phone number will stay the same, but the code will change each day. The staff will call you each morning with the code.

The staff will walk each patient through their preferred connection to the Virtual PHP.
